

MAJOR CHANGES FOR 2017-2018 LCAP After reviewing with parents, teachers and stakeholders progress on the 2016/2017 Actions/Services, and incorporating data gleaned from the CDE dashboard and local indicators, MLCS has added new Actions/Services for 2017/2018 school year. An Action/Service will provide professional development for teachers and paraprofessionals to create a school climate that systematically and comprehensively encourages college aspirations for all students. Another Action/Service will provide students and families with comprehensive information about college costs, options for paying for college, and financial aid and scholarship processes. An Action/Service will be implemented in the 2017/2018 school year that will provide professional development to certificated and classified staff to insure that local indicators for college/career readiness are accurately entered into state-wide student information systems. For elementary and primary students an Action/Service will address positive student and family engagement with the school, and will effectively utilize curriculum to promote lifelong learning. All of the new Actions/Services will fortify Mt Lassen Charter School's vision: "To equip students to think critically across academic disciplines and social/cultural boundaries, preparing individuals to live full and productive lives."

Mt.Lassen Charter School will endeavor to provide all students individualized curriculum choices aligned with California State Standards for a broad course of study. All students will be taught by fully credentialed teachers.
