Students in 9th - 11th grades are expected to complete 60 units per year. Seniors must maintain a minimum of 40 units per year.

College-bound students are advised to contact the colleges they are applying to in order to verify admission requirements prior to the end of their 11th grade year.

Parental permission to engage in the School-to-Work Pathway or Internship is required. Due to the reduced credits for this pathway, students are advised that transferring to another school may result in a credit deficiency.

Students may substitute one year of Physical Education by participating an entire year in an organized or team sport in the school district and pass the physical fitness test.

Any student enrolling in Herlong High School from another school must be enrolled in and pass a minimum of 40 credits during their final semester in order to graduate from Herlong High School, regardless of the credits transferred from another school.
